As a corporate representative of best practise in the United Kingdom, we have a commitment to conducting business in accordance with the International Bill of Human Rights (comprising the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights). Furthermore, we operate in accordance with the UN Framework and Guiding Principles, along with other internationally accepted human rights standards, including; the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises, the International Labour Organisation Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work, and other Core Conventions.
